Checklist for Students

What to do before you arrive:

- Register for Orientation at orientation.umw.edu/register/
- Explore the Orientation website at orientation.umw.edu/
- Set up your UMW email account! All communication will come through your UMW email. Having trouble? Contact the IT Help Desk at helpdesk@umw.edu or (540) 654-2255
- Check your UMW email account every day
- Know your NetID and password. You will use your NetID and password for everything! Having trouble? Contact the IT help desk at helpdesk@umw.edu or (540) 654-2255
- Submit your photo by August 11, 2017 so that your EagleOne University ID will be ready and waiting for you on Move-In Day. Questions? Contact the EagleOne Center at (540)654-1005 or email eagleone@umw.edu .
- Review the map/directions to make sure you are parking in the correct location
- Follow UMW Orientation on social media

Checklist for Students

What you should bring:

- Comfortable clothing and shoes for Day 1 and Day 2. It's casual so no need to dress up! It can be pretty hot during June in Virginia, so it may be a good idea to bring an extra change of clothes. You will have some time in the afternoon on Day 1 to change if you would like.
- One pillow and an extra blanket if you need one (*we provide sheets, towels, and a blanket*)
- Any toiletries that you might need to feel comfortable (toothbrush, soap, shampoo, deodorant, and any other hygiene products you might need)
- Hair dryer or curling iron if necessary
- Alarm Clock/Electronics Chargers
- Pajamas
- Driver's license or government ID (you'll need it to get your EagleOne Card)
- Your UMW NetID and password—you'll need it to register for classes.
- An umbrella —always be prepared!
- Sunscreen
- A photo-ready smile if you've not submitted it for EagleOne
- A good attitude!

Checklist for Guests

What to do before you arrive:

- Register and pay under the “Guests” tab on your student’s orientation registration
- Explore the Orientation website at orientation.umw.edu/
- Make reservations for overnight accommodations. We only provide overnight accommodations for incoming students. You can learn more about local hotels at orientation.umw.edu/families-guests/#lodging .
- Review the map/directions to make sure you are parking in the correct location

What you should bring:

- Driver’s license or government ID
- Comfortable clothing and shoes for Day 1 and Day 2. It’s casual and hot outside so no need to dress up!
- Something to take notes on
- An umbrella and sunscreen —always be prepared!
- Cash for the Parent Reception Cash Bar
- Money for any UMW gear you would like to pick up while you are here
- A good attitude!

Directions and Parking Instructions

Day 1 Parking:

Students and Guests will drive into Double Drive and park in either George Washington Hall, Double Drive, Jefferson Square, or Randolph lots. There will be police officers on site to direct parking.

If you are using a GPS or a phone app for directions, type in “Double Drive, Fredericksburg, VA 22401” for Day 1 parking

Day 2 Parking:

Students will be asked to move their cars to the Marshall Parking lot for Day 2.

Guests will park in the Jepson, Thornton, or Pizza Hut lots. Handicap parking is located in the Anderson Center parking lot. Following Orientation activities, students will pick up their luggage from the Virginia Hall Parlor and walk it to the Hurley Convergence Center to reconnect with guests.

If you are using a GPS or a phone app for directions, type in “Thornton St” for Day 2 parking

Directions and Parking Instructions

Directions from I-95 South (From DC/Northern Virginia)

- Take exit 133A to merge onto US-17 BUS S/Warrenton Rd toward Falmouth
- Merge onto US-17 BUS S/Warrenton Rd (1.8 miles)
- Turn right onto US-1 S/Cambridge St (1.3 miles)
- Turn left onto College Ave (0.5 miles)
- Turn left onto Double Dr

Directions from I-95 North (From Richmond)

- Take exit 130A to merge onto VA-3 E/Plank Rd toward Fredericksburg
- Merge onto VA-3 E/Plank Rd (1.1 miles)
- Use the far left lane to turn left onto William St (0.5 miles)
- Turn left onto College Ave (0.1 miles)
- Turn right onto Double Dr

Directions from U.S. Route 1 North

- Turn right onto College Ave. (0.5 miles)
- Turn left onto Double Drive

Directions from U.S. Route 1 South

- Turn left onto College Ave. (0.5 miles)
- Turn left onto Double Drive

Directions from VA Route 3 East

- Use the far left lane to turn left onto William St (0.5 miles)
- Turn left onto College Ave (0.1 miles)
- Turn right onto Double Dr

Directions from VA Route 3 West

- Turn right onto William St (0.5 miles)
- Turn left onto College Ave (0.1 miles)
- Turn right onto Double Dr
