Checklist for Students

What to do before you arrive.

Know your NetID and password. You will use your NetID and password for everything! Having trouble? Contact the IT Help Desk at (540) 654-2255.
Register for Orientation at orientation.umw.edu/register/.
Set up your UMW email account. All official communication will come through your UMW email. Make sure you get in the habit of checking this account at least once a day. Having trouble? Contact the IT Help Desk at (540) 654-2255 or helpdesk@umw.edu
Submit your FSEM survey and housing agreement so you get the classes you are excited about. A link was sent to your UMW email account.
Download Guide. All these steps and more will be right on your phone! You can set reminders and mark your calendars for important dates. This app will also help you keep track of things onces classes start! Search for "College Simplified", available for Android and IOS.

Checklist for Students

What you should bring.

Directions and Parking Instructions

Day 1 Parking:

Students and guests will drive down Double Drive and park on either the George Washington Hall lot, Double Drive spots, Jefferson Square spots, or Randolph lot as directed.

If you are using a GPS or a phone app for directions, type in "Double Drive, Fredericksburg, VA 22401" for Day 1 parking

Day 2 Parking:

Student who attend orientation unaccompanied will leave their cars parked overnight. Guests will be able to park in the Thornton Lot for their Day 2 activities, located on the corner of Thornton street and College Avenue.

Directions from I-95 South (from DC/Northern Virginia):

- -Take exit 133A to merge onto US-17 BUS S/Warrenton Rd toward Falmouth
- -Merge onto US-17 BUS S/Warrenton Rd (1.8 miles)
- -Turn right onto US-1 S/Cambridge St (1.3 miles)
- -Turn left onto College Ave (0.5 miles)
- -Turn left onto Double Dr

Directions from I-95 North (from Richmond):

- Take exit 130A to merge onto VA-3 E/Plank Rd toward Fredericksburg
- Merge onto VA-3 E/Plank Rd (1.1 miles)
- Use the far left lane to turn left onto William St (0.5 miles)
- Turn left onto College Ave (0.1 miles)
- Turn right onto Double Dr

Directions from US Route 1 North:

- -Turn right onto College Ave (0.5 miles)
- Turn left onto Double Drive

Directions from US Route 1 South:


- Turn left onto College Ave (0.5 miles)
- Turn left onto Double Drive

Directions from VA Route 3 E:

- Use the far left lane to turn left onto William St (0.5 miles)
- Turn left onto College Ave (0.1 miles)
- Turn right onto Double Dr

Directions from VA Route 3 W:

- Turn right onto William St (0.5 miles)
- Turn right onto College Ave (0.1 miles)
- Turn right onto Double Dr
